PFAS

OHM is applying for a \$44 million dollar (forgivable) loan on behalf of the village. EGLE is confident the water system will approved. Expectation is there will be public hearings and feedback. Almost \$1 million has been spent on studies and preparations. Well-house will be out of town, tower by the boy scout building. Pellston School and Pellston Airport are two big customers for the water.
