Owner Water Service Line and Well Abandonment Agreement

Definitions

Village: The Village of Pellston and its engineering firm team members, including subconsultants

Contractor: The Village's designated contractor(s).

Owner: Legal property owner granting permission and access for work.

Property: The service address listed above.

Purpose

In recognition of the Village of Pellston's efforts to provide municipal water to residents and businesses affected by PFAS contamination, the property owner has granted permission—per the attached signed agreement—for the Village and/or its officials, employees, or contractors to excavate and install a water service line as well as well abandonment at the property listed above.

The Owner agrees to grant temporary access and right of entry to the Village and its designated contractor(s) for pre-inspection, construction, testing, and any required adjustments, maintenance, or repairs during the guarantee period.

Standards and Safety Compliance

All work shall comply with applicable AWWA standards for service line materials and installation. Well abandonment shall be completed in accordance with the Michigan Water Well Construction and Pump Installation Code.

Terms and Conditions

1. Water service line will be installed using non-lead materials.
2. Village contractor will supply and install a new water meter; the meter remains property of the Village.
3. Existing private well will be decommissioned by a registered well drilling contractor in accordance with Health Department of Northwest Michigan (HDNW) and State of Michigan EGLE standards; plugging records will be provided to Owner and HDNW.
4. Disturbed property will be restored as close to original condition as possible, including concrete repair and grass seeding (owner responsible for watering). Minor cosmetic variances may occur.
5. Interior piping beyond the meter will not be replaced except to connect new meter to existing plumbing.

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Terms and Conditions Cont'd

- 6. Electrical disconnections of the pumping equipment shall be made in accordance with applicable electrical codes. Any modification to electrical system is responsibility of Owner.
- 7. Contractor guarantees workmanship and materials for one (1) year from completion; exclusions include freeze damage, vandalism, or owner modifications.
- 8. Responsibilities: Village covers initial cost of installation and well decommissioning. Property owner will take over responsibility of service line from property line (Right of Way) to building after installation is completed.
- 9. Owner agrees to hold the Village harmless for damages arising from installation or well abandonment work.
- 10. Village will document work with before/after photos and maintain as-built records in accordance with state service line inventory requirements.
